

Parking Permits

Where to obtain parking permits

All vehicles parked on site and are required to display a current Triangle Apartment parking permit.

Applications for parking permits, throughout the year, may be obtained at the management office, Monday through Thursday 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., except during holidays. When parking in the Handicap spaces, persons with physical disabilities will be asked to display a valid state disability placard or license plate in addition to a Triangle permit. A new academic full year begins during the Summer in July.

Parking permit fees

- \$250.00 per year for covered garage parking spaces
- \$150.00 per year for uncovered rooftop parking spaces

Display of parking permits

The permit holders are responsible for assuring that permits are displayed properly.

All permits must be displayed hanging from rear view mirror with registration facing out. If the vehicle does not have a rear view mirror, or if tinting prevents the decal from being visible, the permit must be placed inside the car window on the driver's side of the front dash. In this case, the permit cannot lie flat and needs to be fully visible from at least ten feet in front of the vehicle. **Parking permits are not transferable from one vehicle to another vehicle without prior approval from the management office.**

Restricted Lot

Lot C (the surface lot) is a restricted lot and requires a staff, commercial tenant, or visitor parking permit. If you park illegally in these areas, additional violations may be assessed.

Commercial Tenant, Vendor and staff parking permits

All commercial tenants, vendor, and staff members are required to obtain a parking permit from the management office. A proper permit will allow the aforementioned to park in the Lot C.

Temporary / Visitor parking

There is visitor parking in Lot C, located in front of Tower 2. Lot C remains can be used by visitors provided the resident obtains a visitor's parking pass. Visitor Parking Permits can be obtained from the management office or the request can be submitted online. Requests should be made at least one (1) business day in advance of the guest's visit. When requesting a visitor parking pass a resident will need the following information: license plate number, color, make, and model of vehicle.

Parking passes must be displayed in the appropriate location on the vehicle at all times. When an unregistered vehicle is parked in Lot C, the vehicle may receive a citation for "failure to register."
