



How to Post a Message

1. Click the link on the triangle website; you will be redirected to our Roommate Finder Forum.
2. Scroll to the bottom of the page and in the center you will see a box called 'Post a New Public Message'. Fill out the sections and click 'send' (or if you wish preview). Your message will be posted above.
3. The page will change to a Captcha Verification page, enter the code and click 'send.'
4. Your message will be posted.

How to Reply to a Message

1. Click the link on the message you wish to reply to. The message will open and the center box (at the bottom of the page) will change to "Post a Public Reply to this Message."
2. Fill out the sections and click 'send' (or if you wish preview). Your message will be posted above.
3. The page will change to a Captcha Verification page, enter the code and click 'send.'
4. Your reply will be posted.

Roommate Finder Guidelines

Please note this website is for use of residents and prospective residents to find roommates here at the Triangle. Posts for other apartment complexes will be deleted. Prior to posting a message please consider the following:

1. When posting a message be careful what information you put on the Internet; names, phone numbers, email addresses, etc. may be accessed by anyone viewing the site.
2. When creating a post be sure to include details that are important to you such as:
 - Cleanliness factor
 - Shared responsibilities
 - Preferences (i.e. non-smoker, male or female, law student, etc.)
3. Posts with profanity or inappropriate language will be removed. All posts are removed after one month unless otherwise requested.
4. Be careful when completing transactions with prospective roommates. Here are some guidelines to help keep you scam free:
 - Try to deal locally with people you can meet in person
 - Never wire funds via Western Union or MoneyGram
 - Never give out financial or personal information such as social security numbers, bank account numbers, or credit card information
 - Be mindful of fraudulent checks and money orders
